ASSISTANT PRINCIPAL'S REPORT Mr James Whitla

It was wonderful to see so many special visitors at school on Wednesday afternoon as part of a busy Education Week participating in activities in the classroom. It was a chance for our staff to showcase some of the different learning opportunities that our students have access to on a daily basis and we were delighted to see so many guests. On Monday and Friday we had visits from our local Kindergartens as part of the extensive transition program that we provide our new students.

Last week our Year 3 and 5 students took part in the NAPLAN testing. The tests were held over three consecutive days in Reading, Writing, Language Conventions and Numeracy and students will receive their results towards the end of next term.

This week we held an Emergency Evacuation Drill as part of our Emergency Management Plan. All of our students are to be commended on the way that they conducted themselves throughout the drill.

Two weeks ago our staff participated in a whole school Professional Learning Day that focussed on developing students' writing skills. All staff have been implementing the 7 Steps to Successful Writing program throughout this semester and this was an opportunity for us to explore the program further. Students' work is already beginning to show the benefits of the program and reading their 'sizzling starts' highlights the breadth and depth of talent that exists among our student body!

Teachers are busy writing end of Semester 1 reports and these will be distributed on 19 June. In the last week of school, teachers will be available to discuss these reports with you in our Parent partnership meetings and there will be more information to follow about how you can book a time to discuss your child's progress.

Next Friday - 29 May, we will be conducting our first official working bee for the year from 3:30-5:00pm. Much of the focus of the afternoon will be centred upon the Prep/Foundation area of the school and we'd love to see as many parents as possible come along to help us with some mulching, weeding, planting and building along the Edithvale Road side of our school.

CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund will ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities.

CSEF will be provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. The allowance will be paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions, or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student will be:

- ♦ \$125 for primary school students
- ♦ \$225 for secondary school students.




There will be another Special Lunch Day this term on Friday 26 June. This is the last day of Term 2 and the Canteen will run a Hot Dog Day.


