SECOND HAND UNIFORM SHOP


The <u>Second-Hand Uniform Shop</u> will reopen next Tuesday, 3 March, at 2:50pm in the School Hall.

We are excited to bring to you the Autumn March / April 2015 Vacation Care program.




Enrolments Start: Monday 2nd March and Close: Friday 20th March 2015




