This term has been brief but eventful and this week's activities have provided a fitting finale to the first guarter of 2013. It was fantastic to see so many grandparents at our special prep morning -the youngest members of our school community were so proud to showcase their school and their classroom—and their grandparents happily joined in all the fun. Students from Years 1 to 4 had a fantastic session with the students from SEDA (Sports and Education Development Australia) who came to conduct a basketball clinic on Tuesday. Yesterday afternoon the senior students in Years 5 and 6 welcomed many of their parents into the learning centre for the official naming of their rooms.
