I attended a Principal's Conference last week (and thank 'Headmaster McMaster' for his leadership in my absence) and was asked to think about the question "What brings you joy?"- a question that we could all think about. As I watch our young son Sam explore and discover his world and see the curious ways in which he learns, I feel genuine joy. This is the same feeling I get sometimes when I see and hear our students learning new skills and knowledge and sharing it with me as I walk through the school grounds. Our 2017 DET School census was held last week and our enrolment figure, which is a key to how our school gets funded, was 344 students. This is up 17 on last year's figure and is a huge vote of confidence for our great school and its community. I am delighted to announce that we received more nominations than there were positions available, and we will need to hold a Ballot. 
MATH'S CORNER




