The last fortnight seems to have flown by and I can barely believe that there are just 30 days left in the school year!

Recently you should have received information about our 2017 Booklists and Fees. We have again kept our fees to a minimum and we believe that in comparison to other Primary and Secondary schools in the area, as well as Kindergarten and other Early Years services - our fees are very, very inexpensive.

This year, in line with the Department of Education and Training's guidelines, our School Council has re-classified some payments as we attempt to streamline our requests for important discretionary contributions. As an example: essential education support items, (ICT hardware, Physical education equipment, Art, French and general classroom supplies) that have traditionally been paid as part of Essential Learning items, now appear in our Voluntary Financial Contributions (VFC) section.

In order to provide all of the current programs that we run, our extra curricula activities and continue to expand our ICT fleet - we will be heavily reliant on receiving your VFC. Please take the time to read through the information provided recently, or check out our website, and help us to continue to make Edithvale Primary School a great place to learn.

Kingston's 2017 Before & After School Program



It's that time of year again! Time to re-enrol your child in Kingston's Epic Before & After School Program for 2017! We have created easy, how to instructions to help guide you through the online re-enrolment

We are now accepting bookings and enrolments online and encourage all families to log into their My Family Lounge Account to re-enrol for 2017. If you have not received, or have forgotten your log in details for your "My Family Lounge"

account, please click here to reset your username and password. Please do not register a new account for your family as you already have an existing online account.

Families who prefer to re-enrol using a manual form can do so by downloading the 2017 Enrolment form from our website or did-there and return it via email or post to our admin team.

If your child will not be attending the Before and After School Program in 2017 please contact our admin team portry us.

How to Re-Enrol for 2017 via My Family Lounge

Using Google Chrome web browser, log into your My Family Lounge account bere using your user name and password (if you do not have Google Chrome you will need to download it)

- In the 'Child' of section of My Family Lounge, 'View or Start' your child's enrolment form and ensure all information is complete and correct
- Upload new documentation to the enrolment form relevant to your child including medical management plans, court orders and risk minimisations
- All medical management plans and risk minimisation forms must be dated within the past 2 years and signed by a medical practitioner
- You are not required to upload your immunisation certificate as we have it from your 2016 enrolment
- In the 'Bookings' section of the enrolment form please state the days of care you require for 2017. Your request will become your 2017 booking.
- At the end of the enrolment form, in the 'Placement Agreement' section add today's date by clicking on the calendar and then click <u>SUBMIT</u> on the left hand side of the screen.

Your work is DONE!

Once we have processed your 2017 Enrolment form and Booking request you will receive an email confirmation of your child's booking within 5 working days. Your 2017 booking will also be shown in your 'My Family Lounge' account in the Existing Recurring Booking section.

Your 2016 Booking will not roll over into 2017. You must complete this process for your child to be enrolled for 2017 for both casual and permanent bookings. We strongly encourage families to submit their 2017 enrolment form as soon as possible to avoid disappointment. If you need help along the way please contact us or alternatively you can download the manual enrolment form, complete it and then return to our Administration Team.
