

Their efforts over the last few weeks to practise their routines were amazing and the culmination was an awesome production. I wish to thank our wonderful school community for their contribution too. Whilst the staff love creating this event, we cannot do it without the support of our great families.





Here is some data well worth sharing and celebrating! Student Attitude to School Survey results are in and there are some pleasing results - and a massive improvement on the 2016 data ©. The data reflects the Excellent Teaching and Learning opportunities and Positive Climate that our dedicated and committed staff provide and it is important to acknowledge and thank them for their efforts.

Friday 1 September, Project Based Inquiry saw our teachers jump fully into the Learning pit! We examined the VCAA Capabilities and found ways to link these with other subject areas. For example linking Ethical Capabilities with History to create a deep and rich inquiry unit for students. "What ethical decisions by leaders have shaped the course of History?" is a question that might be posed for students to delve into. The purpose of the day was to allow teachers to plan units of work that stretch students' thinking and show them how to inquire by asking rich and fertile questions. Over the next 2 weeks, students will be working on these Project based Inquiry units that culminate in an authentic task that showcases their new learning.

Thanks to Dana for all her help on Sushi Day last week. Next term Sushi Days will be on Tuesday 31 October and Tuesday 28 November.


