## Information for Edithvale PS Families



Hi Edithvale Primary School Families and Students,

While our school is closed, we will be using Seesaw for remote home learning. Seesaw will help us work together to provide our students with meaningful learning experiences at home.

We'll use Seesaw to share learning tasks and resources, capture your child's learning, and communicate with students about the work they are undertaking.

If you have time to help your child understand what they need to do we would love you to get involved. As we will be providing students with personalised and individual feedback on some of their work please encourage your child to produce as much work as possible independently. This will help our teacher to get a clearer understanding of student progress during this time and determine what learning goals your child can work on next.

Below are steps for setting up Seesaw at home and additional resources to help you support your child during this transition.

Our students have not used this program previously at school and may need some additional support to get set up and learn how to operate in this space.

### Set up your child in the Seesaw Class App:

1. For devices like tablets or phones, download the **Seesaw Class App**  
For laptop or desktop computers, **go to [app.seesaw.me](https://app.seesaw.me)**
2. Click **I'm a Student**
3. We provided home learning codes: **Enter the text code** or **scan the QR code**
