Our Webex meetings have been successful over the last week. We have enjoyed having a chat with everyone in the class and we hope it gives all the students a lift being able to see their peers.

Our Webex meetings will continue this week apart from Friday 22nd May. The first one being a check-in, going through the day's activities and having a bit of a chat. The second meeting is optional and will be available for the students who would like more clarification on activities, to ask questions or to receive feedback.

This week teachers throughout the school will be using some of their time to create and compose student reports. The structure and format of these reports will look similar to previous progress and end of semester reports, but the content will be a little different. They will reflect the remote learning undertaken at the end of term 1 and throughout term 2.

To help with the planning for transition and reporting, some student work will be receiving comments and likes from staff members in different Year levels- and we will be doing the same in other year levels. This process helps us to moderate our assessments and the collaboration helps to deepen our knowledge and understanding of the learning undertaken throughout the school. To allow this work to happen there will be no Webex Meetings held across the school on Friday 22/5.

Morning Messages:

A morning message will be posted to your child's Seesaw class each morning at 9am. These messages will vary in length and format, and occasionally require your child to respond in some way. These messages will also include any important information your child may need to know (including birthday shout outs!) so it is important your child logs in and views these every day. These will now also include details of daily Webex meetings - links, the learning task to be discussed in the second meeting of the day etc.

An overview of Week 6's learning:

See below for some of the topics/activities to be covered this week:

Reading	Students will be reading aloud for fluency and expression and creating mental images.
Writing	We will begin exploring information reports this week. Students will understand the difference between fact and opinion and begin analysing some informative writing.
Spelling	This week our focus will be on the graph 'y' as in 'pyramid'. It is important that students continue to practice their spelling words daily.
Maths	Students will be challenged to solve some problems involving the concepts of perimeter and area. Our number and algebra focus is still on subtraction and students will continue to further their knowledge and skills in this area.
Wellbeing	Students will continue to engage in lessons from the 'Respectful rights and relationships' program and 'The Resilience Project'.
PBIL	Students will get the opportunity to dive a little deeper into the countries of their choosing from Africa and South America.
