

5/6 Weekly Outline- Week 7

Last week saw the successful introduction of some different WebEx meetings, including the year level group meetings and smaller group meetings in the afternoon. These were received so well by the students that we are planning to keep them going and make them part of our week. This week on Tuesday afternoon, we will do the year level meeting with Year 5 girls, Year 5 boys, Year 6 girls and Year 6 boys again. We will continue with our recommended morning check-in meeting and afternoon meeting schedule as listed below. Class meetings through WebEx continue to be a great way for students to interact with their teacher and peers to help us all feel connected and share our highlights.

The students continue to show their developing independence and skills through the research they have been completing in our Science 'Living Things' Unit. Throughout Week 6 the students have created Wellbeing videos, made games on Scratch and flexed their poetic prose in their first poem about themselves. They have carefully considered units of time and applied these to their problem-solving tasks. The teachers are loving seeing all of the creative and thoughtful ways the students are presenting their thoughts and showing their knowledge. Please continue checking-in with your child and their work on SeeSaw to see their fantastic efforts.

Staff members throughout the school are currently creating and composing student reports. The structure and format of these reports will look similar to previous progress and end of semester reports, but the content will be a little different. They will reflect the remote learning undertaken at the end of term 1 and throughout Term 2.
