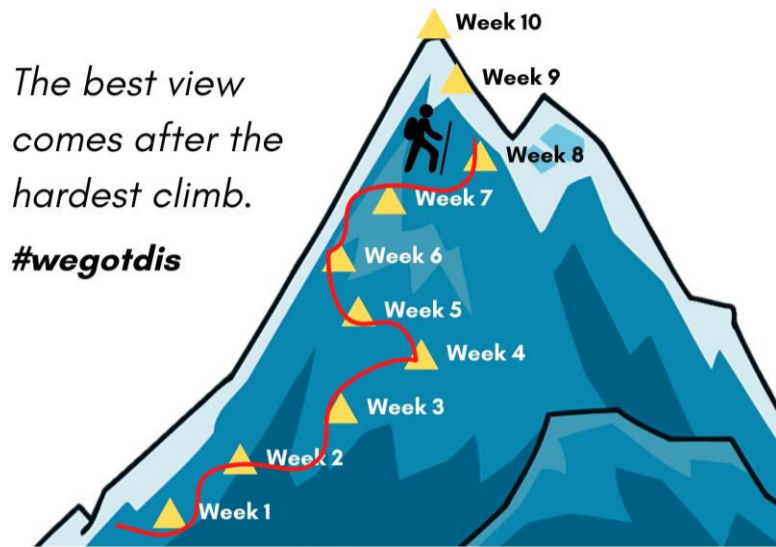
Reading Program
