We have been delighted to see the number of students putting outstanding effort into their learning tasks on Seesaw and being willing to edit work that is sent back to them. It is fantastic to see students carefully reading instructions, viewing videos and checking the success criteria before submitting activities to make sure they have properly addressed the task. As always, please reach out to your child's teacher if there is anything we can do to help you or your child at this time.

On Tuesday we will be having an assessment day. This gives the teachers an opportunity to look through assessments already completed and use this data to plan for Term 4. The students will be set activities which don't require immediate teacher feedback. There may be another assessment task for the students to complete to enable the teachers to have a complete understanding of the students knowledge. Students may have a short WebEx meeting with their teacher and these details will be on the student's Seesaw account.

On September 11 at 10:00am we have an AMAZING treat for our students. Cosentino's School Of Magic workshop is a 30min interactive virtual streaming tutorial designed for all ages and skill levels. Cosentino will share 20 years of professional performance experience teaching students fun, educational and amazing magic tricks using everyday household items (see list below).

Cosentino will first perform and present each magic illusion as it would appear on a live on stage or Television appearance. Then take students step by step through the secret, technique and method to the effect.

An overview of Week 4's learning:

See below for some of the topics/activities to be covered this week:

Literacy	<p>In reading, we will be focusing on cause and effect and comprehension. The students are encouraged to read everyday to assist them with understanding of topics and activities.</p> <p>In writing, we will be putting together the skills we've learned about narrative writing to write a completed story. Students will work on the same story over the course of the week, focussing on different things each day.</p> <p>Our spelling focus for the week is the digraph 'or' as in doctor.</p>
Maths	<p>Students will be completing some assessment related to 'division' as we move into this topic in the coming weeks and into next term.</p> <p>Students will be doing activities related to measuring 'volume and capacity'.</p>
Wellbeing	<p>Students will continue to experience activities adapted from the 'Resilience Project' and the 'Resilience, Rights and Respectful Relationships' programs to assist in looking after their wellbeing during this time.</p>
PBIL/ Science	<p>Our science focus for the remainder of term will be 'Chemical Science'.</p> <p>Students will be exploring the different properties of certain fabrics.</p>

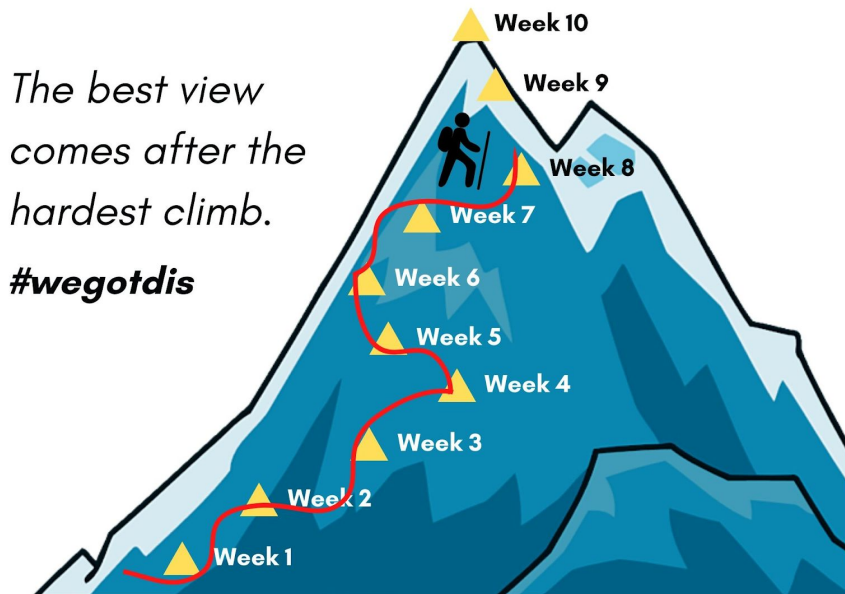
Submitting daily learning tasks:
