Why enrol your child in scouting?

Enrolling your son or daughter in Scouts provides an opportunity for fun educational experiences that are beyond what traditional schooling offers. Modern Scouting aims to develop youth physically, intellectually, emotionally and socially, while encouraging responsibility and decision making strategies to build life-long skills, through the use of hands on learning. Lifelong friendships form through the discovery of new skills and strengths while participating in both indoor and outdoor activities such as camping, hiking, cooking, construction, sports, excursion and games.

Who are scout leaders?

As volunteers from the community and often parents of Scout aged children, Scout Leaders are passionate about developing young people's individual potential. Leaders receive extensive training and must undergo full police and reference checks prior to working with young people on their own. Our Group Sections

Joeys (ages 6 to 8)

Our youngest members learn about themselves, nature, helping other people and having fun in accordance with the theme "Helping Other People".

Cubs (ages 7½ to 11)

Activities at this level are based on the natural sense of fun and enthusiasm of the age group. Cub Scouts are encouraged to overcome challenges and training is achieved through small group activities and games.

Scouts (ages 10½ to 15)

At this level, Scouts begin to follow their own interests with intensity. Our Leaders use these individual interests to develop character in young people with their sense of achievement further boosted through the Scout badge system. Leadership, communication, teamwork and personal responsibility are also focussed on in this level.

Venturers (ages 14½ to 18)

This program is more flexible, allowing members the autonomy to choose activities based on their own interests. Self governance under supervision, plus leadership, initiative and resourcefulness are at the heart of this level.
