## Materials you will need this week:

## Morning Messages

Each morning your child will receive a morning message from their classroom teacher welcoming them to the new school day. These messages will provide a brief outline of what the day entails and will also include a webex link for your child to access the class meeting. These webex meetings will commence at **9am** each morning and are a fantastic way for your child to stay connected with their teacher and peers. The meeting will include important reminders and information for the school day, will be an opportunity to check in and will also include a phonics session similar to what is run daily at school.

### Contacting your teacher

Your child's classroom teacher is available every day to answer any questions you may have about the daily tasks. Each teacher will be available via their Webex room from **10.00am-11.00am**. Students are encouraged to drop into their teacher's Webex room at this time if they have any questions, queries or to receive feedback on how they are going.

For those students in the READ program, Mr Wood will contact each of you and will provide additional sessions between 11.30 and 1.30pm similar to those run at school. Students will receive two sessions per week.
