Travel changes



To enable major works to remove five level crossings and build three new stations, there will be changes to the way you travel to and from school.

From **Monday 19 July** there will be staged closures of four level crossings between Edithvale and Bonbeach to vehicles and pedestrians.

During this time, drivers and pedestrians can cross the Frankston line at Lochiel Avenue, Edithvale, Swanpool Avenue, Chelsea and McLeod Road, Carrum.

Allow extra time to get around the area.

Community shuttle bus

From **9pm Sunday 25 July**, a shuttle bus will operate to connect locals to shops and open pedestrian crossing points. When trains resume on **Monday 2 August**, the route will expand to connect train passengers to Aspendale, Mordialloc and Carrum stations.

Shuttle buses will operate in a loop service **every five to ten minutes**, subject to traffic conditions.

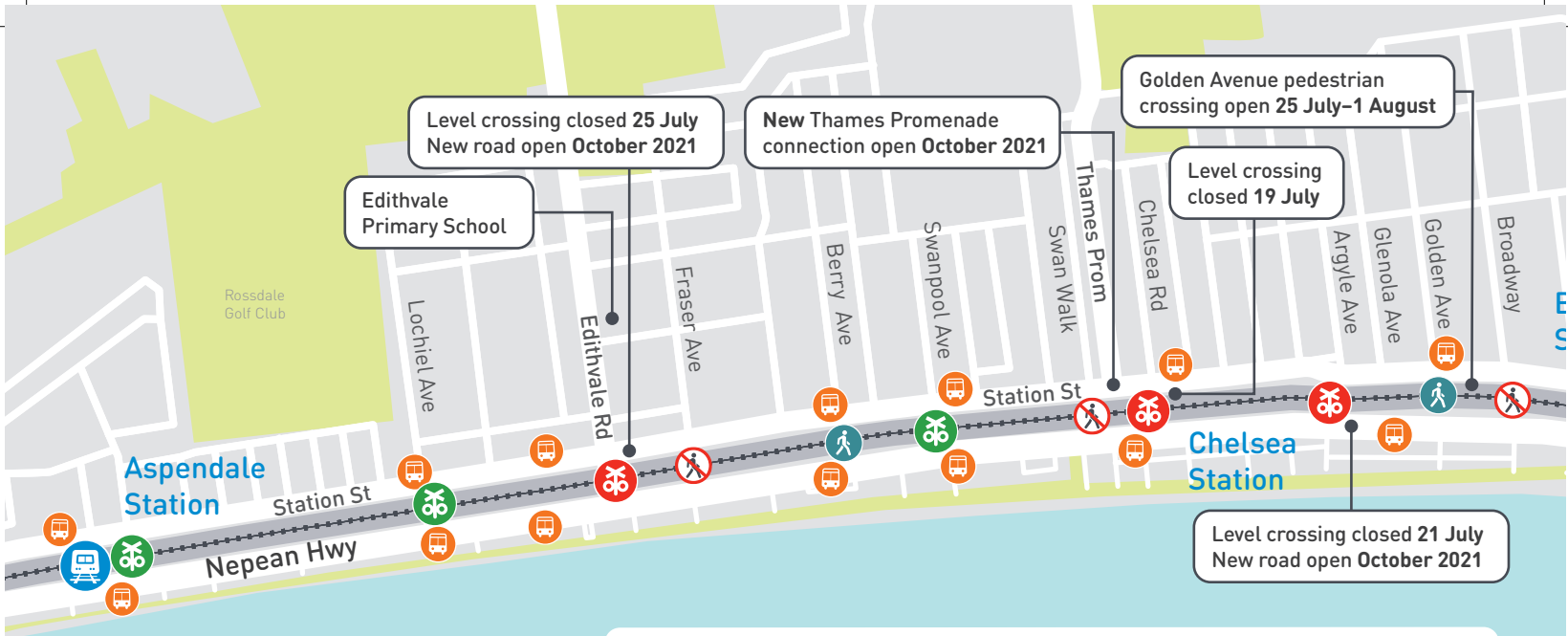
Shuttle bus stops will be located at existing rail replacement and at additional bus stops along Nepean Highway and Station Street. There will be signs on the ground to help you move safely around the area.

By **term four**, the new roads will be open to drivers and pedestrians with no more boom gates, making the school run safer and easier.
