

Year One July Snap Lockdown Overview

Hi Year 1 families,

Next Monday and Tuesday, our students will commence a brief remote learning journey. We know we can do this together and will be supporting your children as much as possible to continue their learning and engagement with us. Our Monday and Tuesday program will feature 4 assigned tasks on Seesaw each day with 2 Webex sessions daily. We will provide feedback via Seesaw and in our face to face meetings. #wegotdis

Here is an outline of what Monday and Tuesday will look like:

Morning Messages

Each morning your child will receive a morning message from their classroom teacher welcoming them to the new school day. These messages will provide a brief outline of what the day entails and will also include a webex link for your child to access the class meeting. These webex meetings will commence at **9am** each morning and are a fantastic way for your child to stay connected with their teacher and peers. The meeting will include important reminders and information for the school day, will be an opportunity to check in and will also include a phonics session similar to what is run daily at school.

Contacting your teacher

Your child's classroom teacher is available every day to answer any questions you may have about the daily tasks. Each teacher will provide an explicit teaching session at 10.30am as indicated above with a particular focus task (Monday Maths and Tuesday nouns, verbs and adjectives) and students will be undertaking the task while meeting and will be able to ask any questions or queries and receive feedback. They will also have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have about other tasks at this time.

READ

For those students in the READ program, Mr Wood will contact each of you and will provide additional sessions between 11.30 and 1.30pm similar to those run at school.

Specialist classes

Below is a specialist timetable for your child's class. Specialist teachers will be available at the below times to answer any queries about the tasks which will be set on Seesaw for their specialist areas. Specialists will set their tasks on the same day they hold their Webex session. Your child's classroom teacher will provide the appropriate webex link to access the specialist teacher's Webex in the daily morning message.
