The morning Webex session will include the following:

- A quick Phonics based lesson
- Explanation of the tasks set for the day and expectations from the teachers
- A reminder for students about what time teachers will be available that day for 'Webex Question Time'.

Your child's teacher will be available on Webex to clarify expectations for tasks, answer questions or provide feedback on completed work between **10.45am - 11.45am**. Log into your teachers personal room during this hour and your teacher will let you into their meeting space. This time is a drop in, drop out type arrangement. Only come if you need and leave when you have the answers you need.
