Morning Messages

Each morning your child will receive a morning message from their classroom teacher welcoming them to the new school day. These messages will provide a brief outline of what the day entails and also include a webex link for your child to access the class meeting. These webex meetings will commence at **9am** each morning and are a fantastic way for your child to stay connected with their teacher and peers. The meeting will include important reminders and information for the school day and be an opportunity to check in and ask any questions your child or yourself may have.

Contacting your teacher

Your child's classroom teacher is available every day to answer any questions you may have about the daily tasks. We will encourage our students to check-in with their teacher during webex meetings or as often as they need. If you have any questions, we will be available to answer them each weekday via the Seesaw platform or on webex between 10:30-11:15am.
