

Year One August Snap Lockdown Overview (part 2)

Hi Year 1 families,

Here is our weekly overview for next week August 16th to 20th. We have included what Friday will look like should this current lockdown period be extended again. We will continue with the same structure: 2 meetings at 9am and 10:30am and 4 assigned activities each day plus specialist classes. #wegotdisagainandagain

Our 10:30am sessions will focus on Literacy or Numeracy and will run Monday through Thursday. Wellbeing will be the key focus on Friday with just 1 session at 9.00 - 9.30am.

Morning Messages

Each morning your child will receive a morning message from their classroom teacher welcoming them to the new school day. These messages will provide a brief outline of what the day entails and will also include a webex link for your child to access the class meeting. These webex meetings will commence at **9am** each morning focused on staying connected with their teacher and peers. The meeting will include important reminders and information for the school day, will be an opportunity to check in and will also include a phonics session similar to what is run daily at school.

Contacting your teacher

Your child's classroom teacher is available every day to answer any questions you may have about the daily tasks. Each teacher will provide an explicit teaching session at **10.30am** from Monday to Thursday as indicated above with a particular focus task and students will be undertaking the task while meeting. Students will be able to ask any questions or queries and receive feedback. They will also have the opportunity to ask any questions they may have about other tasks at this time. On Friday there will be no 10:30am meeting, we will have 1 Webex session from 9:00 to 9:30am.
