Hello wonderful Year 1 families,

We hope you enjoyed the device free day on Friday September 10th and used it as a chance to get out in the sunshine! We were thrilled to see so many people enjoying the Edi Explorers Rally that was held near and around EPS. Seeing families riding, scooting and walking through parts of Edithvale searching for clues was the highlight of our week! Students learnt about direction, map reading and we hope you all enjoyed the exercise! We hope the break from screen time gave you the opportunity to refresh and recharge ready for our final week of Term 3.

Our students have continued to fill our mornings with joy during our daily meetings. Throughout the week we focused on:

- Using the language of chance to describe the likelihood of events.
- Retelling and sequencing a story that we have read.
- Sound marking High Frequency words and writing sentences with correct punctuation.
- Renaming, addition and subtraction strategies.

WEEK 10

In Week 10, our final week of the term, we will continue with the familiar structure of 2 Webex meetings at 9am and 10:30am and 4 assigned Seesaw activities each day plus 1 specialist activity and WebEx session.
